



SUPPLEMENTAL WORK INSTRUCTIONS

AMEROYAL

1. Description:

AMEROYAL is a superior, widely approved treatment for preventing scale deposition and foaming in marine water-making equipment. AMEROYAL is equally effective in seawater, brackish or fresh water. Under certain conditions, it can be used to remove existing scale deposits.

2. Hazards:

1. Wear appropriate personal protective equipment.
2. Eating, drinking, and smoking shall be prohibited in areas where this material is handled, stored, and processed.
3. Workers should wash hands and faces, before eating, drinking, and smoking.
4. Do not get in eyes or on skin or clothing.
5. Do not breathe vapor or mist.
6. Do not ingest.
7. Wear appropriate respirator when ventilation is inadequate.
8. Keep in original container or an approved alternative made from a compatible material, kept tightly closed when not in use.
9. Keep away from acids.
10. Empty containers retain product residue and can be hazardous.
11. Do not reuse container.
12. All operating personnel shall be guided by safety procedures contained in the Material Safety Data Sheet.

3. Storage:

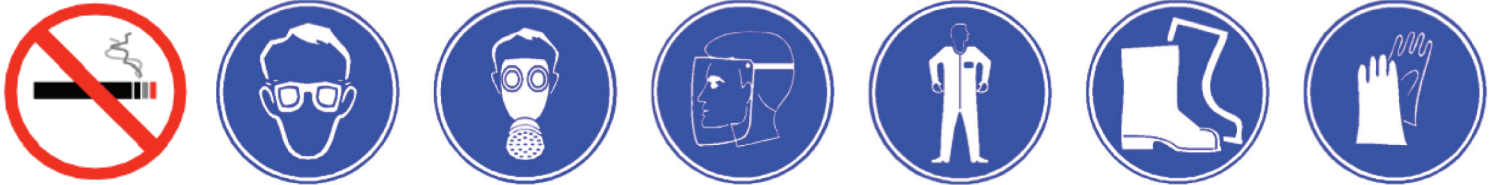
1. Store in accordance with local regulations.
2. Store in original container protected from direct sunlight in a dry, cool, and well-ventilated area, away from incompatible materials, food, and drink.
3. Eliminate all ignition sources.
4. Separate from acids.
5. Keep container tightly closed and sealed until ready for use.
6. Containers that have been opened must be carefully resealed and kept upright to avoid leakage.
7. Do not store in unlabeled containers.
8. Use appropriate containment to avoid environmental contamination.

4. Personal Protective Equipment:

Put on appropriate personal protective equipment when using this product.



5. Directions for Use:

1. The recommended dosage is 30ml per ton of evaporator design capacity. If brine density is increased, adjust dosage proportionately.
2. The recommended dosing rate for AMEROYAL varies with the type of water-making equipment and operation parameters, such as brine density, temperatures, etc.
3. AMEROYAL should be diluted with fresh or seawater and fed continuously, using reliable feed equipment, such as a metering pump or flow meter into the inlet line prior to any heat exchange surfaces subject to scaling.
